CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 4

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF MERRIAM, KANSAS, FROM K.S.A. 12-1640, RELATING TO DEMAND DEPOSITS OF PUBLIC MONEYS AND CERTAIN DUTIES OF THE CITY TREASURER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MERRIAM, KANSAS:

Section 1. EXEMPTION FROM STATUTE. The city of Merriam, Kansas by the power invested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to make inapplicable to it and exempts itself from K.S.A. 12-1640, which applies to said city but not uniformly to all cities.

Section 2. PUBLICATIONS. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed requiring a referendum be held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c) (3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the governing body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, the 23rd day of October, 19 67.

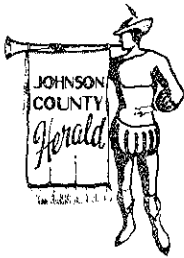

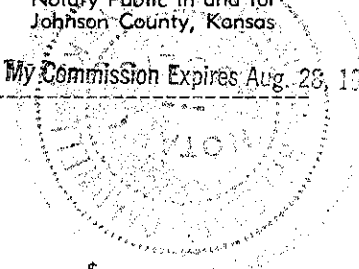
