

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 14

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF MERRIAM, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 79-5028, AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT REMOVING ANY LIMITATION OF AGGREGATE TAX LEVIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MERRIAM, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Merriam, by power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas and as provided by K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 79-5036(a), hereby elects to exempt itself from the provisions of K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 79-5028. K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 79-5028 is part of an enactment commonly known as the Kansas property tax lid law, which enactment applies to this city but does not apply uniformly to all cities.

SECTION 2. The following is hereby substituted for the provisions of K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 79-5028: The provisions of K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 79-5021 to 79-5033, inclusive, and amendments thereto, shall not limit the levy of taxes by the Governing Body of the City of Merriam.

SECTION 3. The Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 4. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the elector voting thereon.

PASSED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF THIS 28 day of June 1993.
