Supply List for Watercolor on Yupo Class

Paints: Artist or Professional grade watercolor tube paint (not student grade, or gouache)
(I use Windsor Newton or Daniel Smith paints.) These are colors that I use – not necessary to bring to workshop – your typical primary color palette is fine.

Prussian blue
Quinachradone coral or Permanent rose
New gamboge
Sap Green
Manganese Blue hue

Brushes: Synthetics are okay – whatever you are comfortable with.
No. 8 and 12 Round brushes -(Daniel Smith platinum series 24) I use several round brushes at a time to mix initial wash
½” Flat brush (Windsor Newton series 985 is very durable – good for lifting)

Paper:
Yupo – medium weight 74lb.

Miscellaneous:
Palette, water container, small mixing cup (ramekin size is good) to premix paint
paper towels
Watercolor pencils if you have them
Backer board, bulldog clips

I work from photos, will have some extras, but best to bring your own.
