

Exterior Stairs

The exterior stairs are 8 feet wide and includes 24 steps with two landings on the main staircase. The west side of the stairs is against the concrete parking structure wall, while the east side of the stairs is grass with a long ADA compliant sidewalk. A crosswalk is located at both the base and the top of the stairs. Two additional sets of stairs are located farther up the path with five steps each.
