CITY PROPERTY TAX CALCULATION EXAMPLE

MARKET VALUE OF HOME \$255,000
CITY MILL RATE 27.665

Assessed Valuation: \$29,325

To determine assessed valuation, multiply market value by 11.5%

\$255,000 x 11.5% = \$29,325

Annual Tax Liability for City Services: \$811.28
To calculate the annual tax bill, multiply the assessed valuation by the mill rate and divide the result by 1,000.
\$29.325 x 27.665 = \$811.276

\$29,325 x 27.665 = \$811,276 \$811,276 / 1,000 = \$811.28

Monthly Expenses for City Services: \$67.61 To determine the monthly tax expenses for City services, divide the tax liability by 12. \$811.28/12 = \$67.61

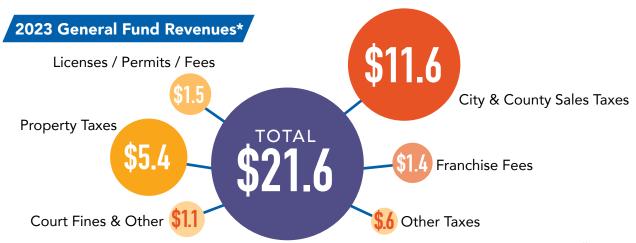

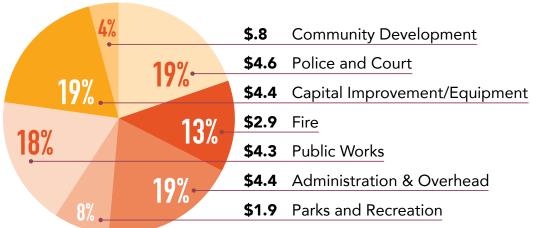
